1a. Andre's family has different tasks to do around the house. Listen to Andre talk about these tasks, and fill in the table below based on what you hear.

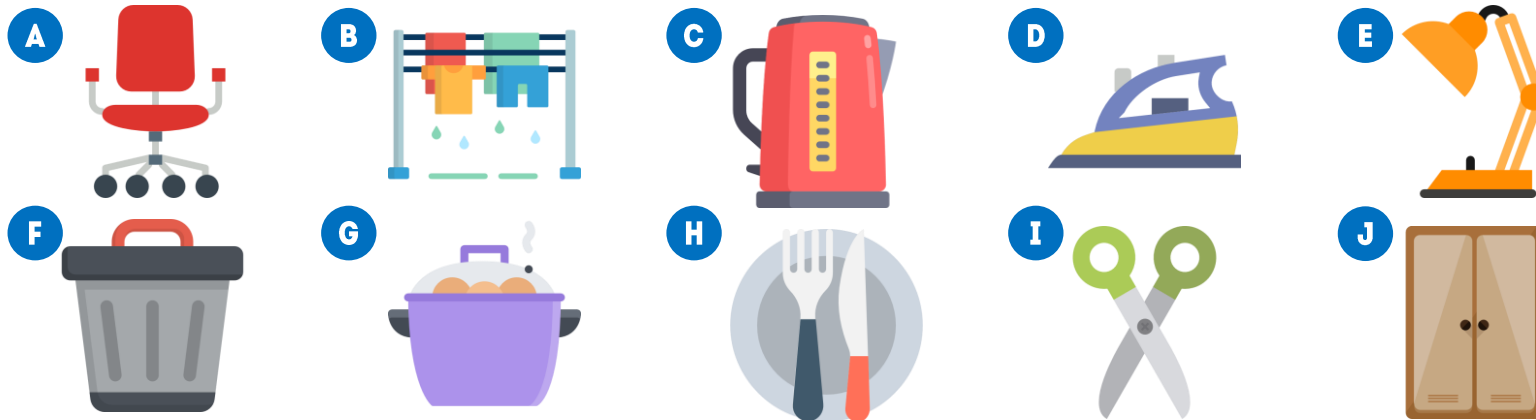

1b. Now, listen to Kevin say two different times on two different days of the week. For each time given, write a complete sentence indicating what chores have already been done on the day, and what chores still must be done. You will need to use the Kristang words *ja* and *mistih* in your sentence.

EXAMPLE Step 1. You hear Kevin say, “It is now 4pm on Wednesday.” in Kristang.
Step 2. You look at your table and write, “It is 4pm on Wednesday. Andre’s father has swept the floor. Andre’s nephew must wipe the plates.” in Kristang.

2a. Kevin has been sent to the Home Appliance and Furniture store to buy items for Fuad’s new house. Listen to Fuad talk about the ten chores that they cannot currently do around the house, and for each chore, choose the corresponding item from below that is needed for Kevin and Fuad to be able to do the chore.



2b. Now, for each chore, write out one sentence in Kristang explaining what Kevin needs to buy.

EXAMPLE For the first item, you write “Kevin and Fuad cannot sit down. They must buy chairs.” in Kristang.
