

At eight o'clock this morning, Mr. Frederic Rowsing **Martens**, secretary of Messrs. Ribb and Co., and Miss Marie Ignes Noronha da Silva, eldest daughter of Mr. C. A. da Silva, of Waterloo Street, were married at the Church of St. Joseph, in the presence of a large gathering of interested friends. The bridegroom is well known in musical circles, being assistant choirmaster of the Cathedral of the Good Shepherd and a pianist of very high attainments. After the marriage ceremony, the bridal party and a good number of guests repaired to the house of the bride's father, Waterloo Street, where the healths of Mr. and Mrs. **Martens** were gracefully proposed by Father Rivet, and enthusiastically drunk. Subsequently the newly married couple went out to Tanjong Katong. They were the recipients of a
